**Exercise 1.** Please complete this exercise before the Judgment Rulings course. Your answers should refer to Law numbers and will not be handed in. The answers will be discussed on the course.

When is it too late to ask for a ruling . . .

- a) about the number of tricks that were made on Board 1.
- b) to dispute declarer's claim that 'the rest are mine'.
- c) if you said 'I'll give you three tricks at the end', but later realise that you only need lose two tricks.
- d) to claim that declarer revoked.
- e) to claim that dummy fielded a psyche.
- f) to claim that you had been misinformed – declarer's hand did not match the explanation dummy gave of it.
- g) to report that the opponents' manner was extremely offensive.
- h) to find out whether the opponents were using an illegal system.
